- Citation Nomination Form
- Claims Against Assessment Criteria
- Team Statement of Contribution For Team nomination only
- Two Letters of Reference
- Digital Photograph

Eligible institutions can submit a maximum of <u>six</u> submissions and the maximum number awarded to each institution is five. In 2022, up to 100 citations will be awarded across the categories below.
