ASSESSORS RECRUITMENT

Currently, we are in the process of recruiting assessors for the 2018 and future rounds of AAUTs.

We are aiming to have a pool of assessors across all disciplines and institutions, with leadership experience in learning and teaching.

Very shortly, we will be emailing you to seek recommendations for assessors from your institution.

Also, we are inviting members from Australian Learning and Teaching Fellows (ALTF) networks, Council of Australasian University Leaders in Leading and Teaching (CAULLT), Australian Promoting Excellence Networks (VTAS PEN, WAND, QPEN, SANTPEN, NSW/ACT PEN), and past University Teacher of the Year award recipients to register their interest in being an AAUT assessor.

AWARDS COMMITTEES

This year, three committees will be responsible for making the final decision on award, citation and program rankings.

These committees will be made up of senior academic leaders in teaching and learning with a track record of leadership and extensive experience in the field across the Australian higher education sector.

UA will appoint the committee members with input from the Awards Team Director.

UA BOARD OF DIRECTORS

The UA Board, consists of Vice-Chancellors from seven universities and the Universities Australia Chief Executive Officer, will sign-off the final outcome of the 2018 AAUT award recipients list.

NOMINATIONS OPEN 5th NOV 2018

As many of you will be aware, nominations for the 2018 round of AAUTs open on the 5th of November.

We have been liaising with ICOs from many of your institutions and are looking forward to receiving high numbers of applications this year.
