Once again, we would like to thank you for your support of the AAUT scheme. Your continued engagement with AAUTs has ensured that momentum has been maintained throughout this period of change.

ASSESSOR RECRUITMENT

We would like to thank you for sending through the recommended assessors from your institutions. We have contacted all your recommendations.

We had a strong response with over 160 people volunteering to be involved.

We are in the process of matching assessors with nominations to ensure no assessor is reviewing nominations from their own institution.

Assessors are currently receiving the outcomes of their Expression of Interest.

AWARDS COMMITTEES

We are currently inviting senior academic leaders in teaching and learning to be part of the Awards Committees.

There will be three committees, Citations, Program Awards and Teaching Awards, each with a team of five to six members including a Chair person and students.

2018 NOMINEE REGISTRATIONS

Phase One of the AAUT submission process closed on Wednesday the 21st November (extended) and we were pleased to see that nearly all institutions registered nominees (41 out of 42 institutions). In total, we received 221 nominee registrations.

Given the tight timeframe this year, this level of engagement is extremely encouraging and a great testament to you all.

AAUT ASSESSMENT PROCESS

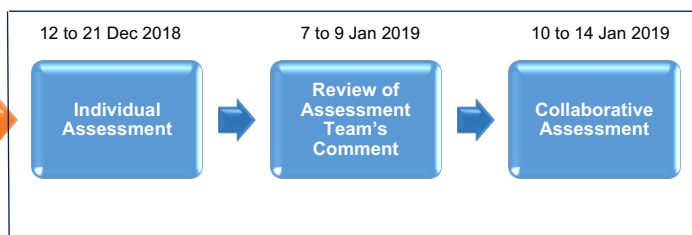
The Assessment process is divided into pre, during and post Assessment.

Pre Assessment prepares the assessor for the assessment process, and includes:

- Viewing Assessor Briefing videos
- Viewing of Assessment Information Packs
- Receipt of Awards Portal Instructions

During the Assessment, the Assessors are required to complete both individual and collaborative assessment.

Post Assessment, the Awards committee will confirm the rating before endorsement and sign off by Universities Australia (UA).
